
Census Factsheet for St. Augustins Parish



This area has been created by aggregating Output Areas (the smallest geography available of around 150 households). It is therefore a "best-fit" match with St. Augustin's Parish.

This area has a resident population of 2,096 and an average household size of 1.6, smaller than the Borough figure of 2.1. The area has a smaller under 18 population and a much larger 65 years and above population than Bournemouth, a comparison that is mirrored on a regional and national scale as well.

The area is slightly more ethnically diverse than in Bournemouth as a whole, with White-British ethnicity accounting for 89.9% of the population in this area.

Self-employment is slightly higher in this area than in the Borough, whilst at 22.4%, the retired population is higher than for Bournemouth. There is a significantly smaller proportion of part-time employees in this area when compared to Bournemouth, whilst a higher proportion work full-time.

Owner occupation is lower in this area than in Bournemouth but the area has a larger public rental sector than in the Borough. The majority of accommodation is in purpose built blocks of flats or similar, a proportion over 4 times greater than the national figure and over twice as large as that for Bournemouth.

Lone Pensioner households account for over 33% of households in this area, compared to a figure of 17.5% for Bournemouth as a whole.

Age Structure

These factsheets use the Key Statistics produced by ONS which do not include an age and gender split therefore retirement age is assumed to 65 for males and females

Ethnicity

Statistics in the England and Wales column refer to England only

Economic Activity

Refers to population aged 16-74

For the Census; part-time is defined as working 30 hours or less a week. Full-time is defined as working 31 or more hours a week.

Accommodation Type

In commercial building' includes in an office building; or hotel; or over a shop.

Household Characteristics

The statistics on car ownership include any company car or van when available for private use.

Overcrowded households are those defined as having 1 or more rooms too few.

A dependent child is a person in a household aged 0 - 15 (whether or not in a family) or a person aged 16 - 18 who is a full-time student and in a family with parent(s).

Occupational Characteristics

Refers to the population aged 16-74

Employment Categories

Refers to the population aged 16-74

Other includes; other community; social and personal service activities; private households with employed persons and extra-territorial organisations and bodies.

Qualifications

Refers to the population aged 16-74
